

Contact Tracing and Affiliate Notification Program

As of COVID-19, the University of the South Pacific (USP) has implemented a contact tracing and affiliate notification program for the year 2022. This program is designed to help identify and notify individuals who may have been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.

Individuals who are identified as being in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 will receive an email to their AU email account from the Affiliate Notification Team. This email will provide information on the individual who has tested positive for COVID-19 and the steps you should take to protect yourself and others.

Individuals who are identified as being in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 **must report** AU contact information to the Affiliate Notification Team.
