#### RUN

 If you are inside and are in inmediate danger, exit as quickly as possible

#### HIDE

 If you are inside and are in immediate danger and unable to exit, hide



#### **FIGHT**

• As a last resort, if you are in immediate danger, fight



### FIRE

Activate the fire alarm

- Evacuate the building
- Notify AUPD 202-885-3636

Evacuate the building using the nearest safe exit or stairwell. Do not use the elevators. Do not move seriously injured persons unless they are in imminent danger. Never try to walk through smoke-filled or other hazardous areas. If you see or smell smoke in the stairwells, close the door and use a different exit. If unable to self-evacuate, shelter-in-place in a room with an exterior window with an operable door. Close all doors and windows and report your location to AUPD by calling 202-885-3636 or by activating the Rave Guardian phone application. Notify AUPD when you exit the building if someone needs assistance.

Keep streets, fire lanes, hydrants, and walkways clear for emergency vehicles and crews. Return to the building when permitted to do so or comply with other instructions given by AUPD.

- Evacuate, if directed by AUPD

# Medical Emergency



Notify AUPD 202-885-3636. Do not move the injured or ill person unless you are under life-threatening circumstances, such as a fire. If possible, have someone meet the AUPD officer at a designated location. If the person is unconscious, retrieve the building AED (if equipped). Activate the AED and follow the voice prompts.

## Weather Emergency



Shelter in place in an interior room above ground level with the fewest possible windows. Remain calm and monitor WH [ W DOHUWV e-mail, or WKH 5DYH \*XDUG for updates on the status of the emergency.
